### **ATTENDING**

### **RESONATOR**

Dan advised that he met with the City and WCI. Various Technical discussions were held and payment discussions were held with all parties. It was negotiated and finalized that the \$60,000.00 was paid to WCI at the end of Sept. The resonators will stay for one more year then the city will keep one and the other will go back to WCI.

### **WEEDS**

All members noticed the proliferation of weeds in the lake this year. No one knew what they were and Lana Haslett will be contacted to see if she knew what they were or could she find out.

### **WATER SAMPLING**

Water samples were taken at 4 different places in the lake. The test results from out past Scott's place included DO, total Phosphorus and temperature. The DO in March was very high and as the water warmed the DO levels became less. Below 5m or 6m the DO is minimal. Below 7m DO was zero. In Sept the DO levels rose again. Phosphorous levels measured over the past two months were consistently higher than the provincial standard. September levels were 20 times higher than the norm.

### **FINANCIAL**

Each sampling round is \$198.00 and the newsletter cost \$500.00. There is no more money and we will need funding sources.

### **NEWSLETTERS**

Some were delivered and more are coming.

### **WEBSITE**

More content is required and it is not published yet. We just have base info so we should have more substance on the website. We should have content for lake monitoring – but no actual numbers. We need more info for the website and more focus should be on the

park. We should focus on the positive such as restoration of the lake to generate good news for the website. We need to figure out how we can promote our website – can we link to Northern Life, Sudbury Star, City of Sudbury and Junction Creek Conservation Committee.

### **FUND RAISING IDEAS**

Some ideas are ice fishing derby, ice hockey tournament for the kids and an skating oval. Brian MacGillivray will look after these ideas.
